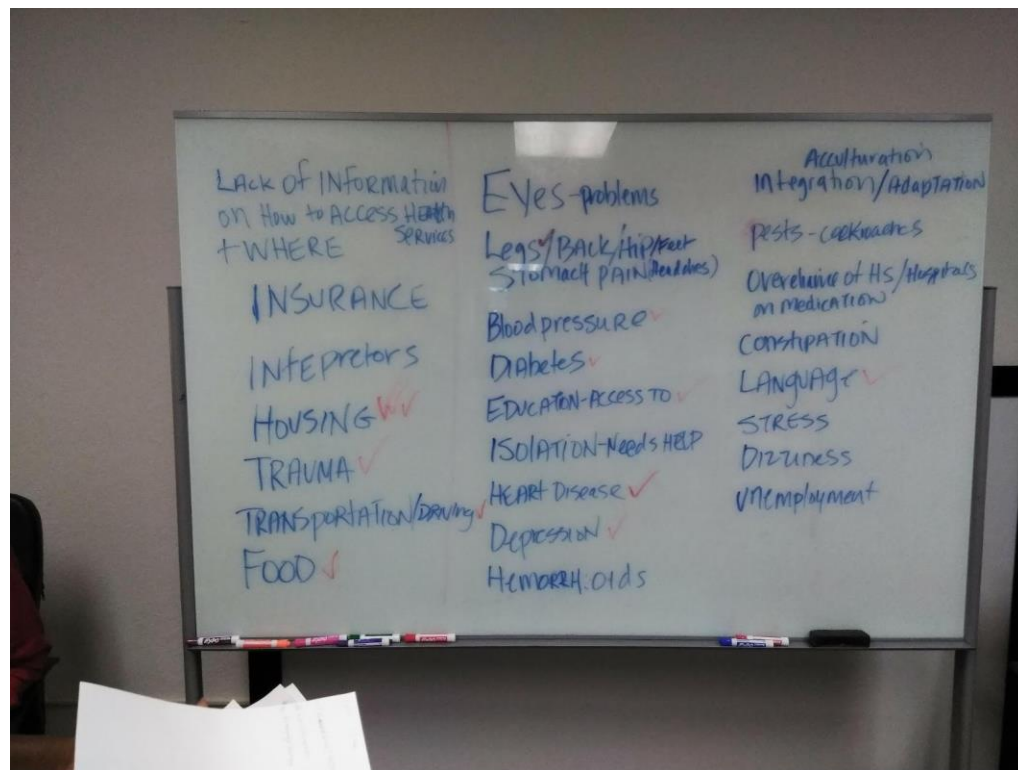
Emergency Communication.

Robin, from Public Health shared emergency communication intake form and participants signed up. Those who enrolled without English language capabilities said that they would be asking their children to read for them or call CIN for language support.

3. Donation of Communication equipment to CIN, a radio and 5 battery chargers

were donated to CIN by Robin Pfohman. This device will keep our organization informed about emergency alerts.

4. This workshop has allowed us to come together as a community and share our cultural food while network with our guest, it was a great time.

5. A participation allowance of 20 dollars was given to all community members who attended this workshop. This money was used to purchase concert tickets that allowed participants to attend a concert organized on the same day evening by a
